Interactive dialogue with High Commissioner
10 September 2012
Remarks by Azerbaijan

Madame High Commissioner,

At the outset, we would like to express our profound respect and gratitude to the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights, Madame Navi Pillay for her leadership and dedication in the promotion and protection of the human rights all over the world. While supporting the activities of the Office, the Government of the Republic of Azerbaijan has made a decision to make modest voluntary contribution to the budget of the Office for 2012.

This Council session is taking place in an important period in the sense that the world community encounters the new emerging challenges and opportunities for the peace, security and sustainable development.
