Madam Vice-President,

The United Nations and its Charter are of vital importance for the promotion of the rule of law among its Member States and for maintaining peace, stability and sustainable development. However, the on-going armed conflicts and resulting destructions and sufferings of civilian population still mark the alarming global trends.

As a country which has experienced a 28 year-long armed conflict and its consequences, Azerbaijan condemns any forms of violent extremism, radicalism and aggressive separatism, and reaffirms once again its unequivocal commitment to the purposes and principles of the UN Charter.

Guided by the above-mentioned, and mindful of its position expressed in many other fora, Azerbaijan once again affirms its commitment to the sovereignty, political independence, unity and territorial integrity of Ukraine within its internationally recognized borders.

Azerbaijan enjoys strong bilateral relations and multifaceted cooperation with Ukraine, and my country fully adheres to the solution of all existing conflicts among the UN Member States on the basis of abovementioned principles of the international law.
